

Core Teachings of the Bible

1. God created all things (Jn 1:3) & is King over all, for His glory. (Ps 47:2)
2. There is only one God (Is 45:5). God is three in person - the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Matt 28:19)
3. Adam and Eve, our first parents, disobeyed God, casting us all into a state of sin. (Rom 5:12-14)
4. God, who is rich in mercy, sent a Savior to redeem those who repent. (Eph 2:4-5)
5. Jesus Christ is God's Son, and the only Savior. (Jn 14:6)
6. After Jesus died for His people, He arose from the grave & now sits at the right hand of the Father. (Rom 6:9)
7. The Holy Spirit gives new life and lives in those who believe. (Rom 8:11)
8. Jesus Christ will come again to this earth on the clouds of glory. (Rev 1:7)

Trusting Jesus Alone Grants Those Who Believe...

Adoption - God adopts those who believe into His family. (Eph 1:5)

Justification - God declares those who believe righteous and holy before Him, based in Christ's work, not their own. (Rom 3:24)

Sanctification - God sets those who believe apart to live an increasingly holy and pleasing life. (1 Cor 1:30)

Glorification - God will give those who believe an eternal and perfect body, like unto His, to be with Him forever. (Phil 3:20-21)

Reconciled to God

The truth is that your greatest need is to be reconciled with your Creator. We have all sinned and rebelled against God. We have chosen to disregard Him and failed to love Him above all things.
